

## **UBIQUITOUS DEVICES**

#### **History of Mobile Telephony**

- Cheyenne Wells, Colorado 1946 first radio-based telephone system
- Late 80's vs. Early 90's cell phones bricks vs. blocks
- GSM (Global System for Mobile Communications) standardization and international roaming in the late 80's
- Carriers begin to off-set cost of handset with long term contracts and market explodes

#### **MOBILE PHONE OWNERSHIP**



#### **DATABANKS RECORD**

- Time / Duration / Sender / Receiver of calls + electronic transmissions
- Cross-analysis to show patterns of personal interaction
- Even go-phones can track and identify user through data
- Where you are
  - Cell towers
  - GPS
  - WiFi (through IP address)
  - Bluetooth (ie: shopping mall and zoo)
  - Always signaling even if turned off
  - Archiving ALL your locations
  - E911 locator
  - Software add-on can turn it into roving bug
  - Augmented reality "tagged" objects
  - Volunteer army of photographers/videographers

## **SURVEILLANCE**

- An exercise of power through watching
- If observation can make people do (or not do) something, then it can be understood as a form of power

#### **PANOPTICON**

 Foucault and concept of constant observation creates "docile bodies" so accustomed to constant observation that they (prisoners) internalized discipline and lost the capacity to resist

#### **SURVEILLANT ASSEMBLAGE**

- Surveillance systems finding or creating differences among people + sorting them into micro categories (risk, value, preference, class, status, age, sex, race, etc.)
- Surveillant assemblage removes individuals and practices from social context into "data"
- Data recombined to provide "objective" representation
  - Data double
  - Data body
- Central force replaced by countless measures in countless locations

#### SOCIAL ARCHITECTURE

- Surveillance systems create pathways and opportunities for human and institutional behavior
- Technologies shape behavior and adaptations

#### **WHY WE SHOULD CARE**

- Information systems
  - Act as Social Architecture
  - Compel participation
  - Enable and constrain
