INITIAL CONCEPT

- Source rape statistics from
 - Buffalo, NY
 - New York State
 - United States
 - University at Buffalo
- Compare statistics (use percentage by population)
- What I found:

Statistics vary WIDELY by state and have grown year over year for decades. The problem is the lack of consistency between states and how they report rape stats. Some police departments are known for "unfounding" reports to keep their numbers low.

SECOND CONCEPT

- Scrape Twitter feed about rape and sexual assault
- What I found:
 - #rape and #sexual assault are used to tag porn sites to drive traffic (while this was not surprising it was disturbing)
 - I had to include #rapeculture to get any of the type of feed I was actually looking for

POSSIBLE WAYS TO USE TWITTER FEED

- Querying the database every 15 minutes would allow for a digital ticker tape of rape tweets
- Tweets could be fed into animation program and read by digital voice to create short film
- Both of these ideas seemed boring and redundant another example of what most people already know
- Neither of these ideas seemed to solve any problems or provide any solutions

 - IN REAL LIFE


WHAT I DECIDED TO DO
